**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2185 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2185 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2185 would clarify that the scope of practice of naturopathic medicine includes diagnostic imaging.

The Board of Healing Arts states that enactment of HB 2185 could increase responsibilities and workload for investigative, disciplinary, litigation, and administrative staff if there is an increase in complaints. However, the agency has no way to estimate the additional number of complaints that would be received or fiscal effect that would result.
