**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2239 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2239 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2239 would allow a person with a liquor premises license to participate in a common consumption area and sell and serve alcoholic liquor from one non-contiguous service area within the common consumption area. Under current law, a person with a liquor premises license may only serve from the current premises covered by the license.

Enactment of HB 2239 would have no fiscal effect on the Department of Revenue, Alcohol Beverage Control. The agency notes that local governments may be required to amend ordinances or resolutions to allow sales in the common consumption permit area. In addition, the bill may change the local law enforcement needs of the areas where the liquor premises licenses would be changed.
