SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2248 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2248 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, all-terrain vehicles are prohibited from being operated on any interstate, federal or state highway. HB 2248 would allow an individual operating an all-terrain vehicle to cross an interstate or federal highway that separates the individual's property provided the highway is crossed by the most direct route.

The Kansas Highway Patrol states the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
