SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2266 by Representative Whipple

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2266 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2266 would prohibit state universities from imposing application fees for scholarships that are based, in whole or in part, on the financial need of the applicant.

The Kansas Board of Regents indicates HB 2266 would have no fiscal effect because state universities do not charge application fees for any scholarships.
