**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2338 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2338 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2338 would exempt Kansas Correctional Industries from various provisions relating to state contract purchases. The bill specifies that any supplies, materials, equipment, goods, printing, or services may be acquired by Kansas Correctional Industries, in accordance with policies adopted by the Secretary of Corrections and would not be subject to various state contract purchase provisions.

The Department of Corrections estimates enactment of HB 2338 could have a fiscal effect on the agency by allowing Kansas Correctional Industries to negotiate contracts; however, the Department cannot estimate a fiscal effect. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2338 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
