**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2365 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2365 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2365 would provide that any notes, records, or reports arising out of a peer support counseling session relating to National Guard members would be confidential and exempt from the Kansas Open Records Act. This provision would expire on July 1, 2024, unless the Legislature acts to renew the provision.

The Adjutant General's Department estimates there would be no fiscal effect to agency operations resulting from the enactment of HB 2365.
