
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2437 by Representative Highland

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2437 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2437 would amend existing law concerning labeling of foods to include meat analogs. The bill would define “meat analog” and specifies the requirements for labeling or advertisement of such a product in order to avoid misbranding. The bill would also make the provisions of the amendment severable from the rest of the act and would make a number of technical corrections.

According to the Kansas Department of Agriculture, enactment of HB 2437 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
