SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2441 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2441 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2441 would authorize all cities and school districts to establish a community historical museum funded by a property tax levy. The new tax levy could not exceed one mill and would be subject to a five percent protest petition.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates HB 2441 would increase the number of cities authorized to levy a tax up to one mill to establish a community historical museum from ten to 625 cities; however, the League is unaware of any cities with this levy.
