SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2541 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2541 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2541 would clarify that certain not-for-profit private postsecondary educational institutions accepting payment of fees, tuition or other charges in the form of a credit card or debit card are not subject to the provisions of KSA 16a-2-403, which prohibits sellers and lessors from imposing surcharges on cardholders who elect to pay by credit or debit in lieu of cash, check or similar means.

The Board of Regents indicates HB 2541 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
