
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2571 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2571 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the spouse of a law enforcement officer is prohibited from obtaining a club and drinking establishment license. HB 2571 would allow the spouse of a law enforcement officer to obtain a club and drinking establishment license, as long as the club and drinking establishment is located in a different county from the county that the spouse serves as a law enforcement officer. The bill would take effect upon its publication in the *Kansas Register*.

The Department of Revenue estimates that HB 2571 would have no fiscal effect.
