SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2583 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2583 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2583 would authorize the owner of a property to petition the governing body of the city to vacate a territory or easement. The bill would require a hearing to be held in front of either the governing body or the planning commission the city. The bill would continue to allow a property owner to appeal a decision by the governing body to district court.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates that HB 2583 would have a negligible fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch. The League of Kansas Municipalities states that the bill would have no fiscal effect on cities. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2583 is not reflected in *The FY 2021 Governor's Budget Report*.
