SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 243 by Senator Hildebrand

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 243 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 243 would prohibit cities, counties and property owners' associations from regulating the occasional sale of lemonade or other nonalcoholic beverages from stands on private property, in public parks or on property in a subdivision by individuals under 18 years of age. The bill would take effect upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates SB 243 could increase public safety costs, but the fiscal effect cannot be determined. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates the bill could create a breach of contract for any county required to regulate the sale of nonalcoholic beverages within any public park. The Association indicates any fiscal effect on licensing or permitting fees would be negligible.
