SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 258 by Senate Committee on Legislative Post Audit

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 258 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 258 would remove requirements to submit certain reports to the Legislative Division of Post Audit. The bill would no longer require nonprofit corporations to give the Legislative Division of Post Audit an audited statement of actual expenditures. SB 258 would also no longer require the Director of Accounts and Reports to certify with the Legislative Post Audit Committee when it writes off accounts receivable or tax receivables. The bill would also remove the requirement that the Board of Regents and other state educational institutions must send the Legislative Division of Post Audit annual audits of certain contractor's independent audit. Finally, SB 258 would no longer require the Secretary of Revenue to give the Legislative Division of Post Audit an annual report on certain information related to tax abatement.

Enactment of SB 258 would have no fiscal effect.
