**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 277 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 277 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 277 would clarify the authority of healing arts school clinics to provide healing arts services. The bill would exempt healing art school clinics from the prohibition against a non-professional business engaging in the practice of healing arts. The bill would also allow for offsite clinics owned or operated by a school in partnership with other providers to engage in the practice of healing arts.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts indicates that enactment of SB 277 would have no fiscal effect.
