SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 324 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 324 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 324 would allow a person to enter into private contracts with healthcare providers for healthcare services and to purchase private healthcare coverage. A person would not be required to participate in any healthcare system or health plan. No person would be required to pay a penalty or fine imposed by the State of Kansas because of entering into a private contract or purchasing private healthcare.

The Kansas Insurance Department and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment both state that the enactment of SB 324 would have no fiscal effect.
