SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 395 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 395 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 395 would amend existing law concerning eminent domain to include carbon dioxide in pipes as one of the substances that may be conducted through land appropriated by various types of companies or corporations including road, oil, pipeline, hydraulic and public utilities, using eminent domain to gain access to that land.

According to the Kansas Corporation Commission, enactment of SB 395 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
