1 AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages; relating to delivery of alcoholic
2 liquors; required reporting, penalty.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) Every railroad company, express company or other
6 common carrier that delivers any alcoholic liquors from outside the state
7 for delivery in the state to consumers shall prepare and file monthly with
8 the director of alcoholic beverage control a report containing: (1) The type
9 of the alcoholic liquors delivered; (2) the name of the railroad company,
10 express company or other common carrier that delivers the alcoholic
11 liquors; (3) the period of time covered by the report; (4) the name and
12 business address of the consignor of such alcoholic liquors; (5) the weight
13 of the package delivered to each consignee; (6) a unique tracking number;
14 and (7) the date of delivery. All reports submitted pursuant to this
15 subsection shall be open records available for public inspection in
16 accordance with the open records act.

17 (b) Upon request by the director, any additional records supporting
18 the report shall be made available to the director by any railroad company,
19 express company or other common carrier. Any records containing
20 information relating to such reports shall be kept and preserved for a
21 period of two years unless the destruction of such records is authorized in
22 writing by the director.

23 (c) Any railroad company, express company or other common carrier
24 that fails, neglects or refuses to file any report pursuant to subsection (a)
25 shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$500.

26 (d) The provisions of this section shall be a part of and supplemental
27 to the Kansas liquor control act.

28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
