1 AN ACT concerning funeral processions; relating to the regulation thereof;
2 violations for not yielding the right-of-way to funeral processions;
3 amending K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 8-2118 and repealing the existing section;
4 also repealing K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 8-2118c.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 New Section 1. As used in sections 1 through 5, and amendments
8 thereto:

9 (a) "Funeral procession" means two or more vehicles accompanying
10 the body of a deceased person, or traveling to the **cemetery**, church, chapel
11 or other location where the funeral service is to be held, in the daylight
12 hours, including a funeral lead vehicle or a funeral escort.

13 (b) "Funeral lead vehicle" means any authorized law enforcement or
14 nonlaw enforcement motor vehicle properly equipped pursuant to K.S.A.
15 8-1723, and amendments thereto, or a funeral escort vehicle being used to
16 lead and facilitate the movement of a funeral procession. A funeral hearse
17 may serve as a funeral lead vehicle.

18 (c) "Funeral escort" means a person or entity that provides escort
19 services for funeral processions, including law enforcement personnel and
20 agencies and groups designated to escort military funeral processions.

21 New Sec. 2. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of state law or local
22 ordinance relating to traffic control devices or right-of-way provisions,
23 pedestrians and operators of all vehicles, except as stated in subsection (c),
24 shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle that is a part of a funeral
25 procession being led by a funeral lead vehicle or accompanied by a funeral
26 escort.

27 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), when the funeral lead
28 vehicle lawfully enters an intersection, either by reason of a traffic control
29 device or at the direction of law enforcement personnel, the remaining
30 vehicles in the funeral procession may follow such funeral lead vehicle
31 through the intersection regardless of any traffic control devices or right-
32 of-way provisions prescribed by state law, city ordinance or county
33 resolution.

34 (c) Funeral processions shall have the right-of-way at intersections
35 regardless of traffic control devices, subject to the following conditions
36 and exceptions:

1 (1) Operators of vehicles in a funeral procession shall yield the right-
2 of-way to an approaching authorized emergency vehicle, as defined in
3 K.S.A. 8-1404, and amendments thereto, using an audible signal meeting
4 the requirements of K.S.A. 8-1738, and amendments thereto, or a visual
5 signal meeting the requirements of K.S.A. 8-1720, and amendments
6 thereto;

7 (2) operators of vehicles in a funeral procession shall yield the right-
8 of-way when directed by a police officer;

9 (3) operators of vehicles in a funeral procession shall exercise due
10 care when participating in a funeral procession and avoid colliding with
11 any other vehicle or pedestrian in accordance with K.S.A. 8-1535, and
12 amendments thereto; and

13 (4) an operator of a vehicle in a funeral procession shall not have the
14 right-of-way at an intersection, if the vehicle is more than 300 feet behind
15 the immediately preceding vehicle in the funeral procession.

16 New Sec. 3. (a) All vehicles comprising a funeral procession shall
17 follow the preceding vehicle in the funeral procession as closely as is
18 practical and safe.

19 (b) In accordance with K.S.A. 8-1523, and amendments thereto, any
20 state law, city ordinance or county resolution stating that motor vehicles
21 shall be operated to allow sufficient space, enabling any other vehicle to
22 enter and occupy such space without danger, shall not be applicable to
23 funeral processions.

24 (c) Each vehicle that is a part of a funeral procession shall have such
25 vehicle's headlights, either high beam or low beam, and tail lights lighted
26 and may also use flashing hazard lights if the vehicle is so equipped.

27 New Sec. 4. Nothing in sections 1 through 3, and amendments
28 thereto, shall be construed to prohibit any city or county from requiring:

29 (a) A law enforcement or nonlaw enforcement funeral lead vehicle or
30 funeral escort for a funeral procession. A city or county and may require
31 prior notice of a planned funeral procession be given to the city police
32 department or the county sheriff; or

33 (b) compliance with any other city ordinance or county resolution,
34 not in conflict with the provisions of this section.

35 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as
36 follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except
37 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the
38 notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial,
39 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified
40 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be
41 taxed as provided by law.

42 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person
43 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive

1 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as
 2 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs
 3 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the
 4 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment
 5 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in
 6 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment
 7 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no
 8 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right
 9 to trial and plea of no contest.

10 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly
 11 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed
 12 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose
 13 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of
 14 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference
 15 only and is not a legal definition.

20 (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
 21 shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
 22 ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
 23 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
 24 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
 25 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
 26 contained in subsection (c).

27 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
 28 (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
 29 defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
 30 adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
 31 within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
 32 amendments thereto.

33 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
 34 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-
 35 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction
 36 shall be fined 1½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of
 37 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
 38 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments
 39 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or
 40 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be
 41 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the
 42 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
 43 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909,

1 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of
2 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon
3 conviction shall be fined $2\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but
4 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in
5 subsection (c).

6 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
7 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a
8 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school
9 zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

10 (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto,
11 within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and
12 amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for
13 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A.
14 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior
15 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon
16 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding
17 violation.
