1 AN ACT concerning criminal procedure; relating to sureties; surrender of  
2 obligor by surety, release of surety; amending K.S.A. 22-2809 and  
3 repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 22-2809 is hereby amended to read as follows: 22-  
7 2809. Any person who is released on an appearance bond may be arrested  
8 by such person's surety or any person authorized by such surety and  
9 delivered to a custodial officer of the court in ~~any~~ the county in the state ~~in~~  
10 ~~which such person is charged~~ *where such bond was issued*. Such person  
11 who is arrested as provided in this section shall be brought before any  
12 magistrate having power to commit for the crime charged. The magistrate  
13 shall indorse on the bond, or a certified copy of such bond, the discharge  
14 of such surety upon the sworn statement, either written or oral, of the  
15 surety setting forth the reasons for the discharge. The magistrate may  
16 commit the party who is arrested as provided in this section. Such person  
17 committed as provided in this section shall be held in custody until  
18 released as provided by law.

19 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 22-2809 is hereby repealed.

20 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
21 publication in the statute book.
