Good morning Chairman Rahjes and members of the Committee, I appreciate the opportunity to present written testimony on behalf of the Kansas Farm Bureau (KFB) in support of HB 2103. KFB is the state's largest general farm organization representing more than 30,000 farm and ranch families through our 105 county Farm Bureau Associations.

HB 2103 will help facilitate the proper disposal of unwanted pesticides by reducing the financial burden associated with the disposal and reduce the human exposure risk by having the waste pesticides packaged, shipped, and disposed of by professionals. This use of the Kansas Agricultural Remediation fund seems appropriate to help alleviate some of the costs of the safe disposal of these products.

KFB is supportive of this bill as it is a modest step in the right direction to ensure that Kansas Agriculture can continue to thrive while protecting the environment. We fully support passage of HB 2103.
