I firmly feel that some action must be taken to curb the overreach of our Federal Government into affairs that are best left to the states and local government. The Federal Government has gone far beyond the intent of our US Constitution to force nationwide compliance in matters that of which it has little knowledge of the local situation. The states put the Federal Government in place. Now the Federal Government is micromanaging the states.

I am close to local teachers, students, and school board members. Overreach is having a negative impact on their lives. As an example of overreach, I cite the COVID situation.
