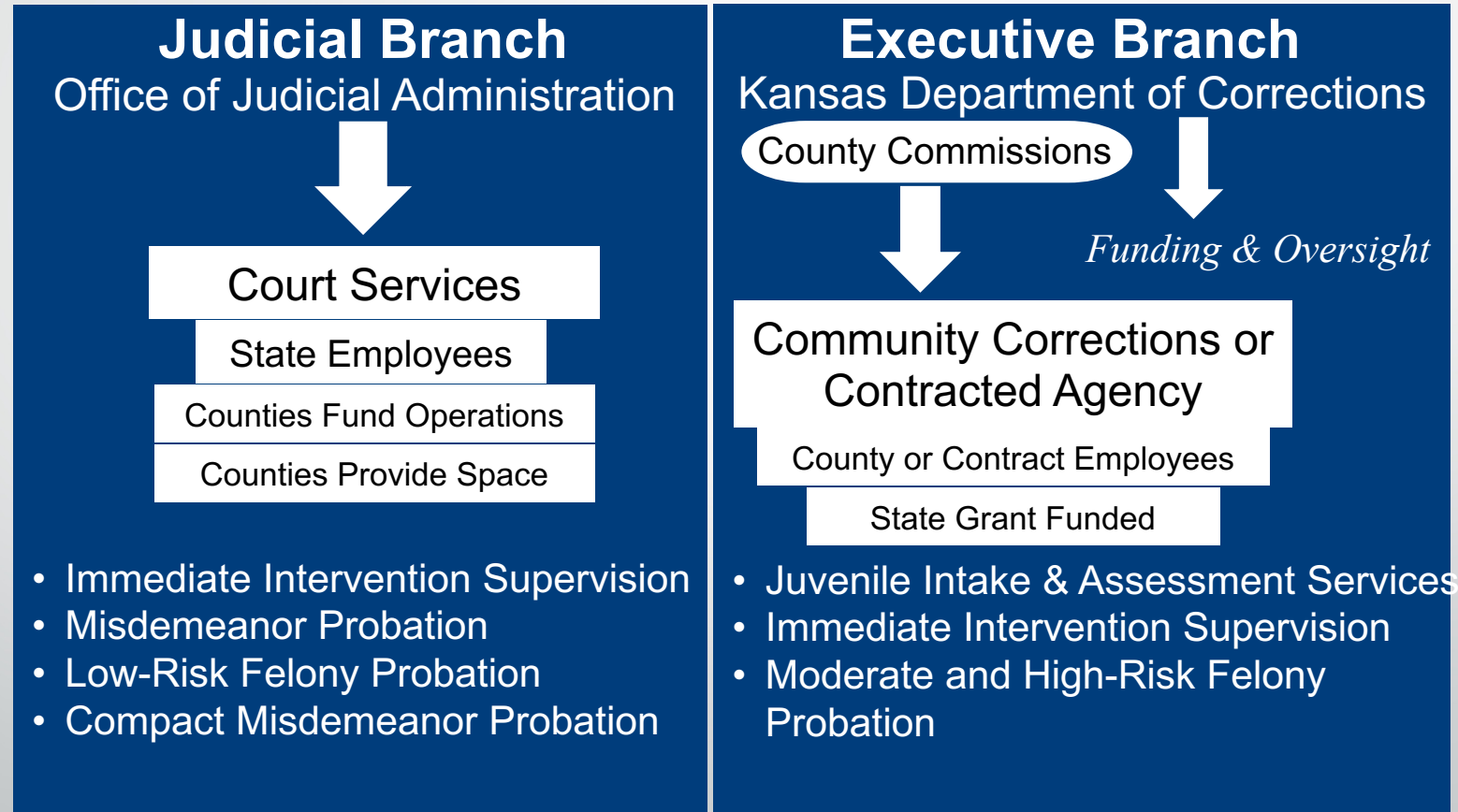

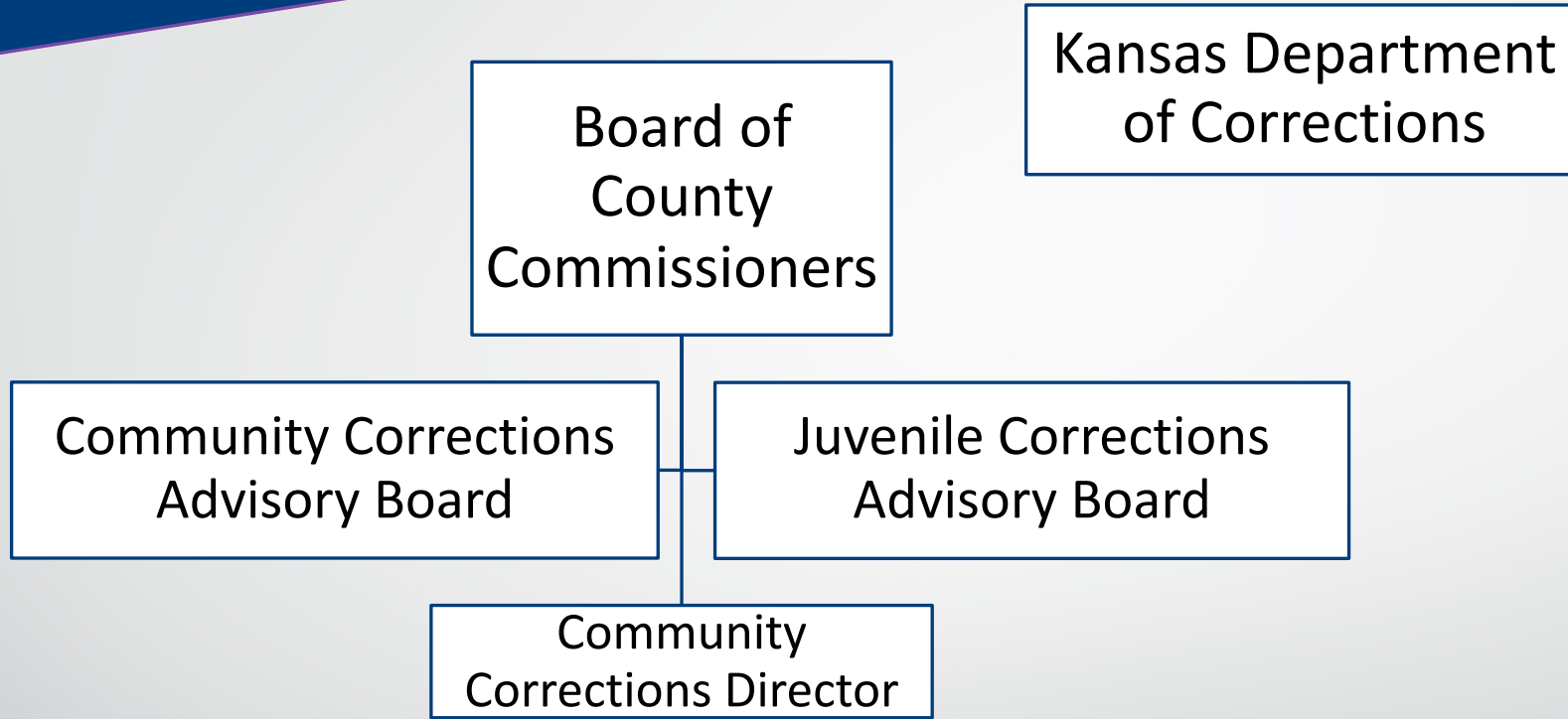

 - Employment & Residential Services

Community Corrections in Kansas

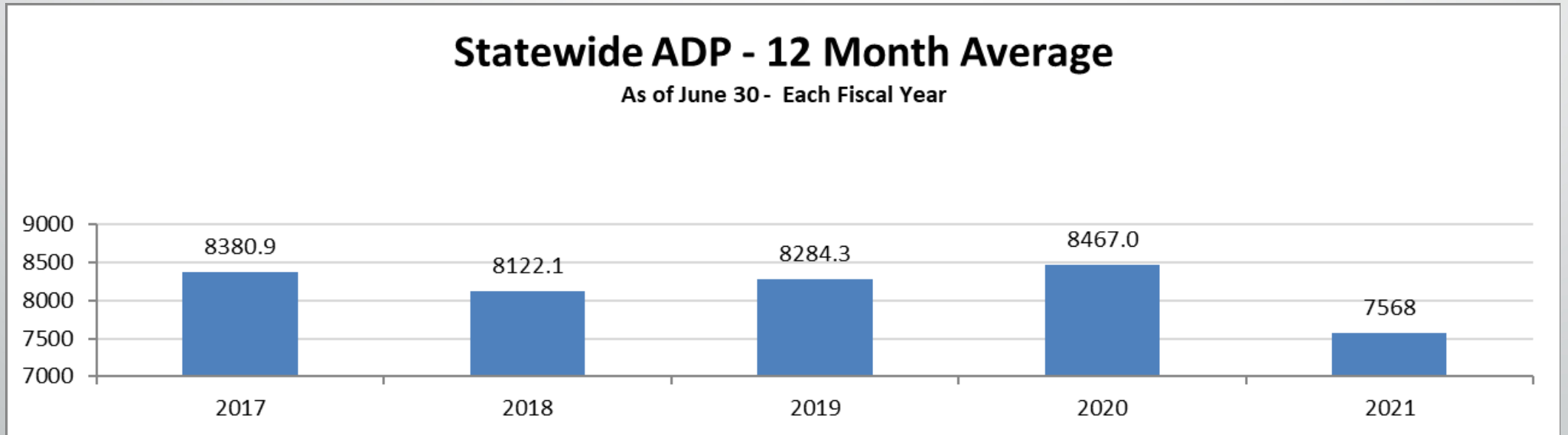
Placement of Offenders

- Felony offenders
- Presumptive prison sentence but receive a non-prison sentence as a result of a departure
- Severity Level 7 or higher offense
- Offenders who violate conditions of release
- High risk or high needs or both

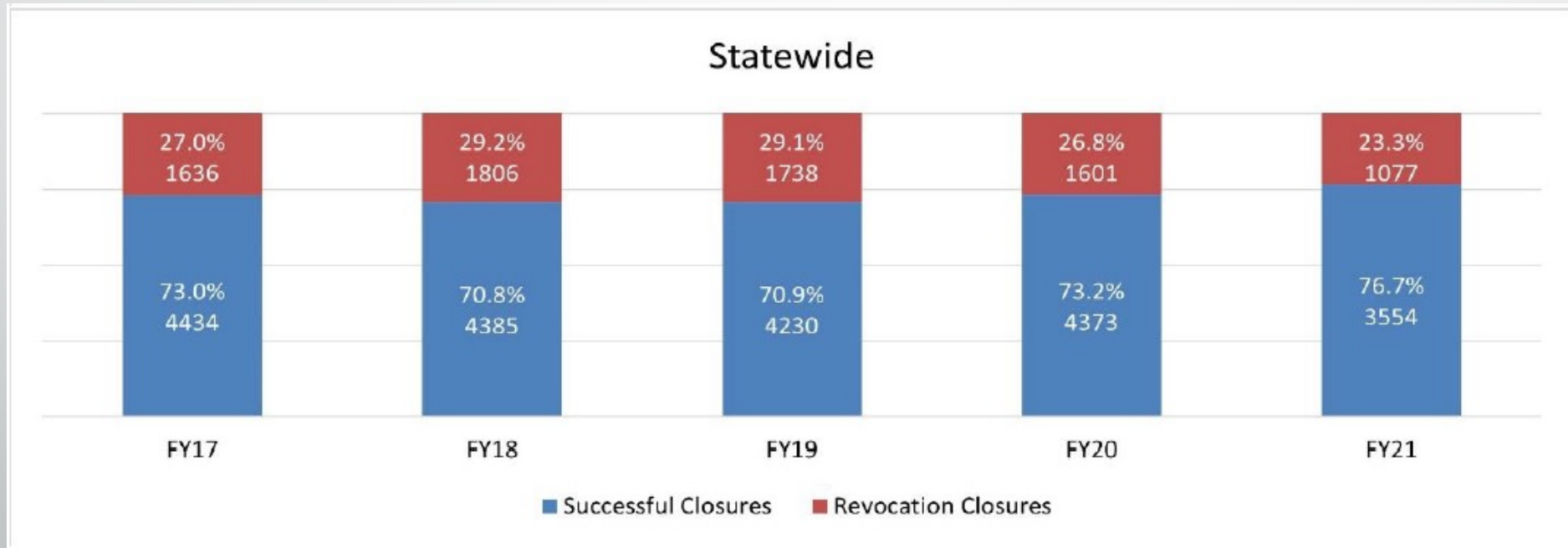
