I Kamaljeet Bhandal Licence Cosmetologist from last 15 years in kansas (license number 000-2131 and missouri and a shop owner in missouri, I am working as threader from last 25 years and would request the Jury not to take the License away from threading as this is how it benefit the clients and practitioner:

- 1) Clients won't like to get there services done from an unlicensed and unprofessional technician working in a salon which will impact our sales and cost of eyebrowthreading will be low. A place which is not inspected by a inpector will not be clean or safe or disinfective the employees won't be train enough to keep it updated to the standards of a salon.
- 2) we use a coton thread to pull the hair from the root then the skin pore are left open and we have to give a little (which hazel ) liquid on a tissue to the client's to close it then the long hair of the eyebrows are comb and cut with the scissors.

if the license is taken away an inspection will be never done on us sissors comb will be left diry will be used on each client diry from the same disinfective water which will cause infections.

- 3) when a client gets infected because the pore gets open and or there skin is very sensitive to pull hair our insurance company take care of there medical bills if there is no licence required for threading insurance company might refused to pay medical bills for the clients and it might come uo to the salon owners or employees which is another impact.
- 4) The benifit we get from the license for threading is we get an inspection done each year the inspectors come they check us explain us how to keep the place disinfective and clean for the clients and safe for ourself, During this pandemic we get update how to keep our salons updated from the state board of cosmetology which is imported for us and our clients saftey.

I am a handicap women from 7 years mother of two kids work full time as a threader and my husband i a patient of mentel health on social security since 2013 we work very hard in this pandemic to make ourliving by taking our the license away you will take away the food away from our tables as the clients won't like to feel safe enough to get the service from us. amam 02/02/2022
