Subject: Senate Bill No. 127

## **Summary**

Senate Bill No. 127 increases eligible age for online license renewal, approves electronic notices for expiring licenses and removes a disqualifier for obtaining restricted driving privileges.

<u>Section 1</u> – increases the eligible age for electronic online renewal of licenses from 50 to 65 years of age.

<u>Section 2</u> – allows the division to send the required expiration notice 30 days prior to the license expiring by email if authorized by the person.

<u>Section 3</u> – removes the disqualifier from obtaining restricted driving privileges for those individuals who have previously received a stayed suspension as a result of a driving while suspended conviction.
