Subject: Senate Bill No. 100

Summary

Senate Bill No. 100 excludes the additional 90-day period for suspended licenses for certain individuals, the bill removes a limitation from restricted driving privileges and the bill removes and delays payment for fees that apply to individuals for failure to comply with a traffic citation.

<u>Section 1</u> – Removes the additional 90-day period for those individuals who have been found guilty of driving a vehicle while the license of such person's license is suspended for failure to comply with a traffic citation.

Section 2 – Removes the \$25 nonrefundable application fee for restricted driving privileges. The section further specifies that an applicant will not qualify for restricted driving privileges unless there is no other basis for the license suspension or cancellation except for failure to pay fines for traffic citations. Additionally, the disqualifier from restricted driving privileges is removed for those individuals who have previously received a stayed suspension as a result of a driving while suspended conviction.

The section also amends the \$100 reinstatement fee for licenses from \$100 per offense to a \$100 reinstatement fee.
