Subject: House Bill No. 2633

Summary

House Bill No. 2633 provides for a new distinctive license plate – the City of Hutchinson license plate. The plate would be subject to the 250 initial plate commitment and payment of up to \$5,000 in development costs as such requirements are set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141. The City of Hutchinson, with the Division of Vehicle’s approval, would be able to assist with the design of the plate. The City of Hutchinson would be able to use its flag image as its logo. Additionally, the City of Hutchinson would be able to set an annual royalty fee in the amount of \$25 up to \$100 for the plates and such fees would go to a designee of the Hutch Rec Foundation. Any change to the designee would have to be made only by mutual agreement of the City of Hutchinson and the Hutch Rec Foundation.
