

Transportation Technology Development Fund Proviso

Add language to allow public and private postsecondary educational institutions to apply for and receive grants from the Transportation Technology Development fund in the Kansas Department of Transportation for FY 2023. This language will waive the requirement for applicants to partner and projects be administered by Local Units of Government and allow Universities to match the grants with other State funding.

SB 422

On page 220, following line 21, by inserting:

Provided, That notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 75-5093, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, expenditures shall be made by the above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, from the transportation technology development fund to allow postsecondary educational institutions, as defined in K.S.A. 74-3201b, and amendments thereto, and private postsecondary educational institutions, as defined in K.S.A. 74-32,163, and amendments thereto, to apply for grants from such fund: *Provided further*, That postsecondary educational institutions and private postsecondary educational institutions may use state moneys as a match for such grants.
