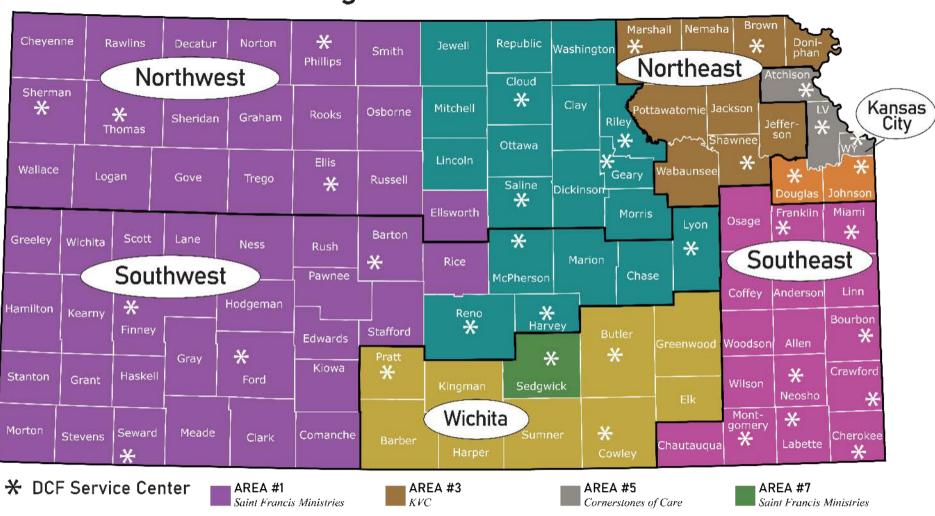

Case Management Provider Monthly Payment Rates

These are the payment schedules for each of the 8 grants. The highlight is the estimated caseload range for each area during the bid process. There are 8 different pay schedules because each catchment area was competitively bid.

The rate changes when caseloads change by 10%.

As caseloads decrease between tiers, the monthly payments decrease by 5.5%. If caseloads increase to the next teir, the monthly payment increases by 7%. The difference in change up versus down recognizes the fixed costs the grantee maintains when caseloads decrease.

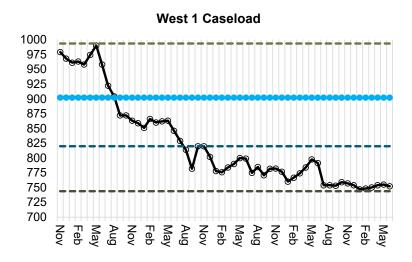

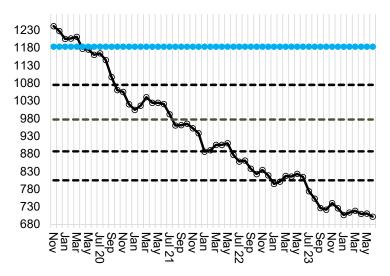
Attachment 3 Graph of Case Management Payments Actuals & CCE Estimates

These charts show the child caseload by catchment area and how payment amounts change. The blue line was the projected caseload when bid. Each dotted line represents a 10% caseload change where rates change.

Monthly CMP payments decrease 5.5% when going down and increase 7% when going up. The increase or decrease in monthly rates adjusts for costs of 10% fewer or more children.

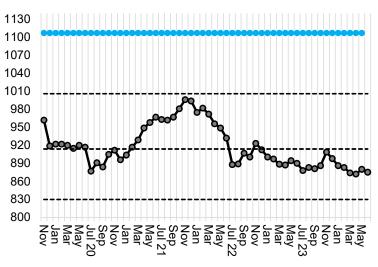

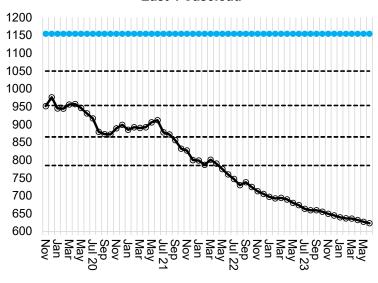

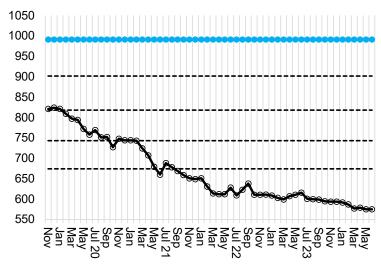




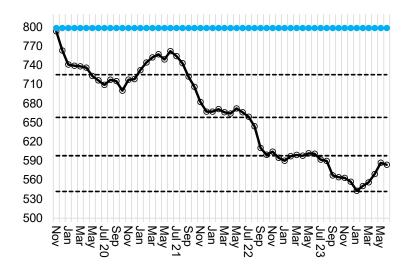
East 4 Caseload



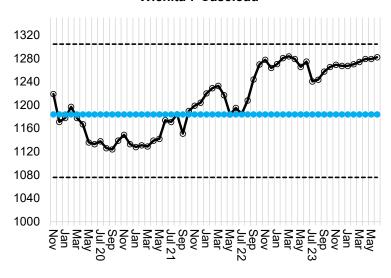
KC 5 Caseload



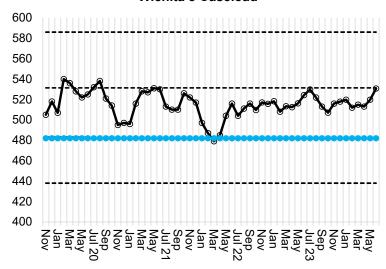

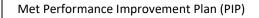

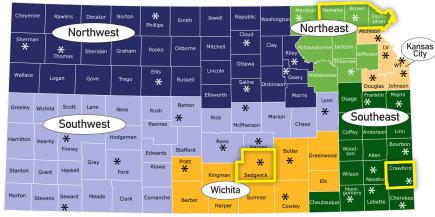
