
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2204 by House Committee on Agriculture

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2204 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2204 would amend existing law concerning labeling of foods to include meat analogs. The bill would define “meat analog” and specifies the requirements for labeling or advertisement of such a product in order to avoid misbranding. The provisions of the bill would be severable from the rest of the act and the bill would make a number of technical corrections.

According to the Kansas Department of Agriculture, enactment of HB 2204 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
