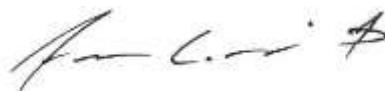
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2295 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2295 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2295 would exempt municipal motor grader vehicle operators from the Kansas Uniform Commercial Drivers' License Act requirements if they are operating the motor grader vehicle within the boundaries of the municipality where they are employed.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates that enactment of the bill would have a negligible effect on cities that could be absorbed within existing resources. The Department of Revenue and the Department of Transportation state that the bill would have no fiscal effect. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2295 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor's Budget Report*.
