
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2530 by House Committee on Agriculture

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2530 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2530 would prohibit the use of identifiable meat terms on the labels of meat analogs when such labels do not include proper qualifying language to indicate they do not contain meat. The bill would also add several definitions to the Kansas Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, including “meat analog,” “identifiable meat term,” and “close proximity to the identifiable meat term.”

The Department of Agriculture indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
