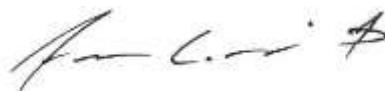
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2596 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2596 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2596 would allow school districts to contract with a transportation network company (TNC) to transport eight or fewer persons to and from school or school-related activities. In addition, the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education concerning the transportation of students shall not apply to TNCs.

The enactment of HB 2596 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts or the operations of the Department of Education. Any costs would be borne by local school districts would choose to contract with a TNC.
