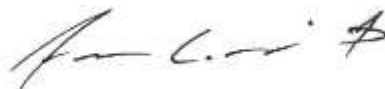
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2688 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2688 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2688 would provide that if an applicant for a Cereal Malt Beverage (CMB) license has already been issued a farm winery license, the CMB license application must be approved by the board of county commissioners or the Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

The Kansas Department of Revenue indicates HB 2688 would have no fiscal effect.
