
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2707 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2707 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2707 would expand the election crime of corrupt political advertising to be consistent with the Campaign Finance Act and clarify the scope of its application. The bill would expand the election crime of corrupt political advertising to include telephonic communication, electronic communications, and printed communications.

The Kansas Secretary of State and the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission both state the enactment of HB 2707 would have no fiscal effect.
