
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 278 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 278 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 278 would require sponsoring organizations which charge a fee for distinctive license plates to report the total amount of revenue received by the organization from the plate fee the previous year and a list of expenditures paid for from that revenue. The report must be made no later than May 1 of each year to the House Committee on Transportation, the Senate Committee on Transportation, the Legislative Research Department and the State Treasurer.

According to Legislative Administrative Services, the Legislative Research Department and the State Treasurer, enactment of SB 278 would have no fiscal effect on state expenditures or revenues.
