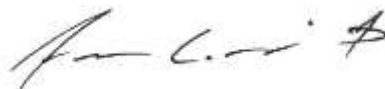
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 346 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 346 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 346 would extend the sunset date for current milk and dairy license fees from June 30, 2023, to June 30, 2028. The bill would also allow the Secretary of Agriculture to declare an imminent health hazard when necessary to protect the public health. The Department of Agriculture would also be able to assess a civil penalty for certain violations.

The Department of Agriculture indicates that the enactment of the bill would not create any changes from current law and would have no fiscal effect
