
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 368 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 368 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 368 would amend current law to specify that Internet trading in child pornography or aggravated Internet trading in child pornography would be a registerable offense under the Kansas Offender Registration Act.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations. The Kansas Sentencing Commission indicates the bill's enactment could have an effect on prison admission and beds; however, the Commission does not have enough information to estimate what that effect would be. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 368 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
