
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 395 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 395 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 395 would prohibit Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks law enforcement officers from conducting surveillance on private property unless authorized under a warrant, the constitution of the United States, or certain exceptions of the search warrant requirement which are detailed in the bill.

The Department of Wildlife and Parks states that the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
