
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 418 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 418 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 418 would prohibit the Governor or any other officer in the Executive Branch of Kansas from entering into any consent decree or other agreement with any state or federal court or any other party regarding the enforcement of election laws or alteration of election procedures without specific approval of the Legislative Coordinating Council.

The Offices of the Governor, the Secretary of State, and Legislative Administrative Services and the Judiciary all state that enactment of SB 418 would have no fiscal effect.
