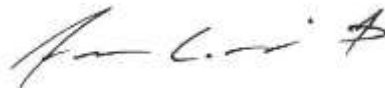
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 458 by Senate Committee on Transparency and Ethics

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 458 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 458 would require contact information of appointments by the county chairperson, county committeemen, and committeewomen be provided to county election officers no later than three days after appointment. The bill would define "primary election" as the election held on the first Tuesday in August of even-numbered years.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that SB 458 would have no fiscal effect.
