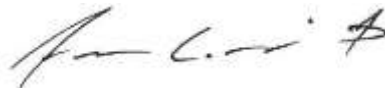
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 477 by Senate Committee on Utilities

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 477 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 477 would require the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) to provide information pertaining to any rule, charge, practice, or procedure of a board of public utilities, upon written request, to any residential or commercial customer of electric utilities regulated by the Commission who have a monthly electric demand of 69 kilowatts or less. The bill would require the information provided by KCC to indicate whether the rule, charge, practice, or procedure differs, and the extent to which it differs.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates the enactment of SB 477 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
