
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 485 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 485 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 485 would allow funds received by a candidate who is subject to the Campaign Finance Act for expenses incurred for family caregiving services. The bill would define “family caregiving services” as care for an individual who is an immediate family member under 18 years of age; disabled; or qualifies for senior care services.

The Kansas Secretary of State’s Office and the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission indicate that SB 485 would have no fiscal effect on the Office or Commission, respectively.
