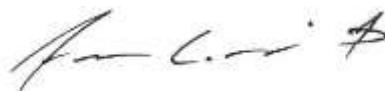
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 51 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 51 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 51 would require the Kansas State Department of Education and the Department for Children and Families to collaborate in preparing an annual academic report on certain educational outcome data for foster care students attending public and accredited nonpublic schools. The report would be submitted on or before January 15 of each year to the Senate Committee on Education and the House Committee on Education.

The Department for Children and Families and the Kansas State Department of Education indicate the enactment of SB 51 would have no fiscal effect on either agency.
