
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 53 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 53 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 53 would establish the membership of the Sedgwick County Charter Commission to recommend changes and review the structure of county government.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates Sedgwick County would incur costs related to carrying out the functions of the Commission. However, the Association is unable to estimate the fiscal effect. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 53 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor's Budget Report*.
