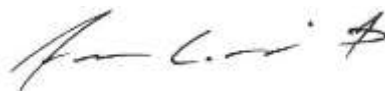
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 6 by Joint Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice Oversight

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 6 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 6 would amend the domestic battery definition of “conviction” to include any criminal offense that includes a domestic violence designation.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of SB 6 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations. The Sentencing Commission indicates enactment of the bill could have an effect on prison admissions; however, the Commission cannot estimate that effect. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 6 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor’s Budget Report*.
