AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas public employees retirement system and systems thereunder; affiliation and membership of certain security officers of the department of corrections in the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system; providing for employee and employer contributions.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "security officer" means the same as defined by K.S.A. 74-4914a(1)(a) and (b), and amendments thereto.

- (b) On and after July 1, 2021, the department of corrections shall be an eligible employer as defined in K.S.A. 74-4952, and amendments thereto, and shall affiliate on July 1, 2021, with the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system established under K.S.A. 74-4951 et seq., and amendments thereto, pursuant to the provisions of this section for membership in the system for security officers who are employed by the department of corrections. The department of corrections shall make application for affiliation with such system in the manner provided by K.S.A. 74-4954, and amendments thereto, to be effective on July 1 next following application. The department of corrections shall affiliate for membership in the system of such employees for participating service credit.
- (c) The division of the budget and the governor shall include in the budget and in the budget request for appropriations for personnel services the amount required to satisfy the employer's obligation under this section as certified by the board of trustees of the system and shall present the same to the legislature for allowance and appropriation. Upon affiliation, the department of corrections shall pay to the system a sum sufficient to satisfy such obligations as certified by the board.
- (d) The determination of retirement, death or disability benefits shall be computed upon the basis of credited service, as used in K.S.A. 74-4951 et seq., and amendments thereto, and shall be for all participating service with the department of corrections as a security officer.
- (e) Any security officer who becomes a member pursuant to this section, who has a vested retirement benefit pursuant to K.S.A. 74-4917, and amendments thereto, and who terminates employment prior to

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attaining a vested benefit pursuant to K.S.A. 74-4963, and amendments thereto, may have such service credited for purposes of computing retirement benefits pursuant to K.S.A. 74-4901 et seq., and amendments thereto.

- (f) (1) Each security officer employed by the department of corrections on the date of affiliation of the department of corrections may become a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system on the first day of the payroll period of such security officer coinciding with or following the entry date of the department of corrections, only by filing with the board of trustees of the system, on or before the entry date of the department of corrections, a written election to become a member of the system. Failure to file such written election shall be presumed to be an election not to become a member of the system. Such election, whether to become a member or not to become a member, shall be irrevocable.
- (2) Each security officer who is on an authorized leave of absence or is in the military service on the entry date of the department of corrections may become a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system on the first day of the first payroll period of such security officer coinciding with such security officer's return to active employment and the department of corrections' payroll, only by filing with the board of trustees of the system, within 10 days after such return to active employment, a written election to become a member of the system. Failure to file such written election shall be presumed to be an election not to become a member of the system. Such election, whether to become a member or not to become a member, shall be irrevocable.
- (3) Every person who is first employed as a security officer on or after the entry date of the department of corrections into the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system shall become a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system.
- (g) Except as otherwise provided by this act, any security officer employed by the department of corrections who becomes a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 74-4951 through 74-4970, and amendments thereto.
- (h) Beginning with the first payment of compensation for services of a security officer after becoming a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system, the employer shall deduct from the compensation of such member 7.15% as the employee contribution to the system. Such deductions shall be remitted, deposited and credited as provided in K.S.A. 74-4965, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
