

**HOUSE BILL No. 2295**

1 AN ACT concerning drivers' licenses; relating to commercial drivers'  
2 licenses; exempting municipal motor grader vehicle operators from the  
3 Kansas uniform commercial drivers' license act requirements;  
4 amending K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 8-2,127 and repealing the existing  
5 section.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 8-2,127 is hereby amended to read as  
9 follows: 8-2,127. Vehicles that are exempt from this act include:

10 (a) Farm vehicles, defined as follows:

11 (1) Registered as a farm truck or truck tractor under K.S.A. 8-143,  
12 and amendments thereto;

13 (2) used to transport either agricultural products, farm machinery,  
14 farm supplies, or both, to or from a farm;

15 (3) not used in the operations of a common motor carrier; and

16 (4) used either *in*:

17 (A) ~~in~~ intrastate commerce; or

18 (B) ~~in~~ interstate commerce within 150 air miles of any farm or farms  
19 owned or leased by the registered owner of such farm vehicle;

20 (b) vehicles operated by firefighters and other persons ~~which~~ *that* are  
21 necessary to the preservation of life or property or the execution of  
22 emergency governmental functions, are equipped with audible and visual  
23 signals and are not subject to normal traffic regulation. These vehicles  
24 include fire trucks, hook and ladder trucks, foam or water transport trucks,  
25 police SWAT team vehicles, ambulances or other vehicles that are used in  
26 response to emergencies;

27 (c) military vehicles ~~which~~ *that* are operated by military personnel in  
28 pursuit of military purposes and all noncivilian operators of equipment  
29 owned or operated by the United States department of defense. This  
30 applies to any active duty military personnel and members of the reserves  
31 and national guard on active duty, including personnel on full-time  
32 national guard duty, personnel on part-time training and national guard  
33 military technicians, civilians who are required to wear military uniforms  
34 and are subject to the uniform code of military justice or the Kansas code  
35 of military justice;

36 (d) motor vehicles, ~~which~~ *that* would otherwise be considered

1 commercial motor vehicles, if such vehicles are used solely and  
2 exclusively for private noncommercial use and any operator of such  
3 vehicles; ~~and~~

4 (e) farm tractors operated by an implement dealer, or employee  
5 thereof, when moved or transported in accordance with K.S.A. 2020 Supp.  
6 8-1918, and amendments thereto; *and*

7 (f) *motor grader vehicles operated by an employee of a municipality,*  
8 *as defined in K.S.A. 75-6102, and amendments thereto, if such employee is*  
9 *operating the motor grader vehicle within the boundaries of such*  
10 *municipality.*

11 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 8-2,127 is hereby repealed.

12 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
13 publication in the statute book.
