1 A RESOLUTION condemning the Russian invasion of Ukraine and  
2 urging the United States federal government to provide aid and  
3 support to the Ukrainian people.

5 WHEREAS, Ukraine is a free, democratic, independent and sovereign  
6 nation with its own distinctive culture and language; and

7 WHEREAS, In 2014, Russian armed forces occupied the Crimean  
8 region of Ukraine, and the Russian Federation subsequently annexed  
9 Crimea in violation of international law; and

10 WHEREAS, In 2014, armed insurgents supported by the Russian  
11 Federation also occupied portions the Ukrainian provinces of Donetsk  
12 and Luhansk, where they remain to this day; and

13 WHEREAS, On the morning of February 24, 2022, naval, air and  
14 ground forces of the Russian Federation launched a premeditated and  
15 unprovoked attack on the people and the nation of Ukraine: Now,  
16 therefore,

17 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas:*  
18 That we condemn the Russian invasion of the nation of Ukraine and stand  
19 in solidarity with the Ukrainian people; and

20 *Be it further resolved:* That we urge the United States federal  
21 government to provide aid and support to the Ukrainian people in their  
22 struggle against this aggression; and

23 *Be it further resolved:* That the Chief Clerk of the House of  
24 Representatives shall send an enrolled copy of this resolution to the  
25 Ukrainian and Russian ambassadors to the United States and three  
26 enrolled copies to Representative Highberger.
