1 AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; relating to certified community
2 behavioral health clinics; establishing certification and funding
3 processes therefor; prescribing powers, duties and functions of the
4 Kansas department for aging and disability services and the department
5 of health and environment related thereto.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) The Kansas department for aging and disability
9 services shall establish a process for certification of and funding for
10 certified community behavioral health clinics in accordance with this
11 section.

12 (b) The Kansas department for aging and disability services shall
13 certify as a certified community behavioral health clinic any community
14 mental health center licensed by the department that provides the
15 following services: Crisis services; screening, assessment and diagnosis,
16 including risk assessment; person-centered treatment planning; outpatient
17 mental health and substance use services; primary care screening and
18 monitoring of key indicators of health risks; targeted case management;
19 psychiatric rehabilitation services; peer support and family supports;
20 medication-assisted treatment; assertive community treatment; and
21 community-based mental healthcare for military servicemembers and
22 veterans.

23 (c) (1) The department of health and environment shall establish a
24 prospective payment system under the medical assistance program for
25 funding certified community behavioral health clinics. Such system shall
26 permit payment by either daily or monthly rates.

27 (2) The department of health and environment shall submit to the
28 United States centers for medicare and medicaid services any approval
29 request necessary to implement this subsection.

30 (d) The secretary for aging and disability services and the secretary of
31 health and environment may adopt rules and regulations as necessary to
32 implement and administer this section.

33 (e) The Kansas department for aging and disability services and the
34 department of health and environment shall implement this section not
35 later than July 1, 2021.

36 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
