1 AN ACT concerning distinctive license plate fees; requiring reporting by
2 sponsoring organizations of income and expenditures derived from
3 such fees.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. Not later than May 1 of each year, any organization that
7 receives payment from any fee imposed on the issuance or renewal of a
8 distinctive license plate shall submit to the house of representatives
9 committee on transportation, the senate committee on transportation, the
10 legislative research department and the state treasurer a report on the prior
11 year's finances that contains the following information:

12 (a) The total amount of money received by the organization from
13 such distinctive license plate fee from the prior year; and

14 (b) the list of expenditures that the money in subsection (a) was spent
15 on by the organization.

16 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
17 publication in the statute book.
